The first known town meeting within the area of modern Otego was held in 1802 in a farm house about one mile southeast of the Otsdawa crossroads with 43 members present.6. One of the first schools in the town of Otego met in Phineas Cook's clothing mill.7. By 1810, the Otsdawa is listed with its own Post Office.
